Members discussed the various options (standstill, +5% and +10% on present Precept £29606).

It was agreed:-

a)to increase the Precept by 10% for the year 2013/14 calculation £29606 + 10% 2961 = 32567 less DCC grant £7504 = £25063), therefore the Precept will be £25063. subject to the following:-i)the Council agree a budget based on the above figures ii) The Council look closely at all Income/Expenditure for 2013/14 iii)The Council reconsiders the provision of Christmas trees for 2013. Note this was agreed by all Councillors at the meeting
